


## Author A.C. Frieden Meets Chicago Bulls Player Thabo Sefolosa

Thabo began his professional career in Switzerland's top domestic league, the LNA with Tege Riviera Basket in 2001 and then spent the next three seasons competing in France for Chalon-Sur-Saone in France's top league. In 2005, he signed with Italian club Angelico Biella, and was then drafted by the Philadelphia 76ers with the 13th overall pick in the 2006 NBA draft, and his draft rights were immediately traded to the Chicago Bulls.
