

A.C. Frieden Signs Books at Centuries & Sleuths Bookstore

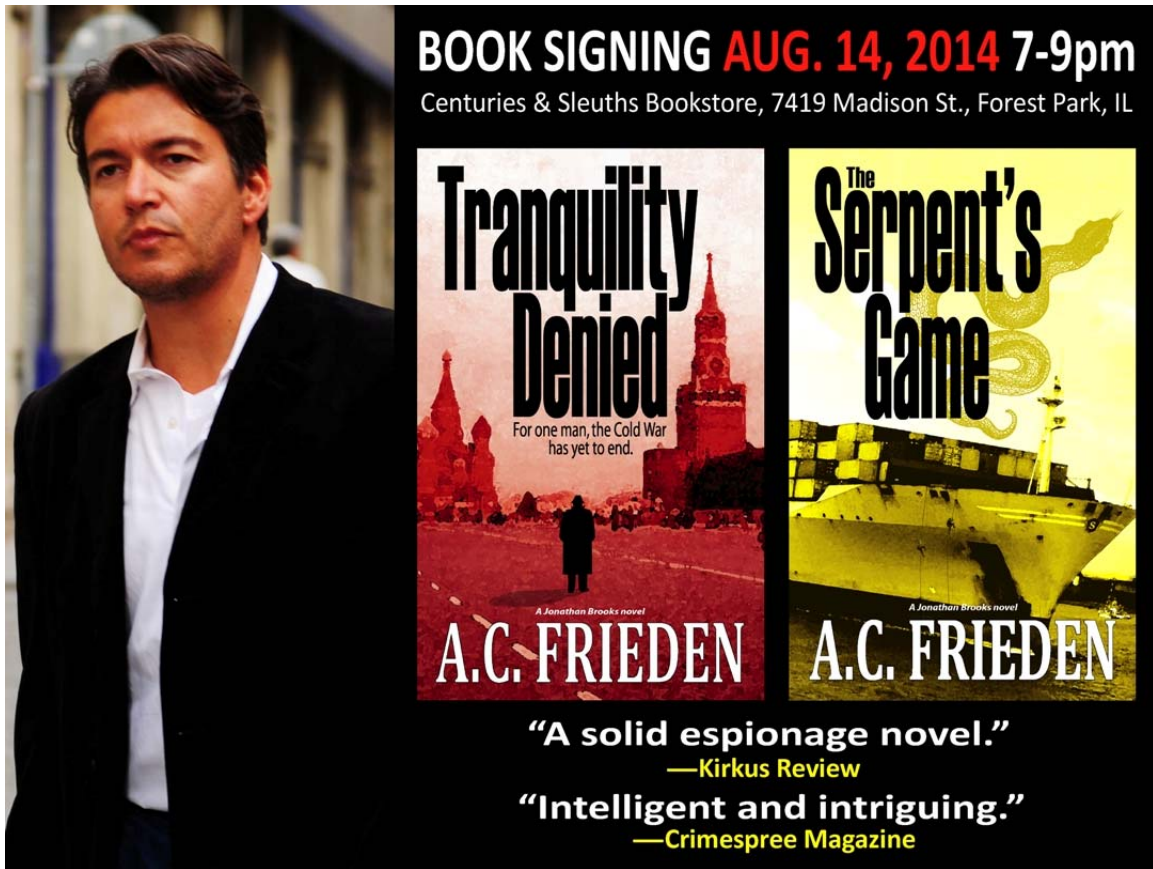

Since it's opening, the bookstore has hosted hundreds of authors and remains a steadfast supporter of the Midwest Chapter of Mystery Writers of America, which Frieden is a member. MWA monthly meetings are often held at the bookstore, and the store also helps support sales at local events where MWA has a key presence, such as at the annual Printers Row Lit Fest.
